





Material

Metal units - structural steel Plastic units - HDPE, polyamide

Duplex powder coated with coat curing Hot-dip galvanizing

Ropes - polypropylene with a steel internal core

### Description

The support structure of the rope bridge is made of structural steel which is protected against corrosion by zinc coating, resulting in a very prolonged service life of the workout elements or duplex powder coated with coat curing according to RAL to prevent corrosion. The structure is fixed in a concrete bed. All other metallic elements are also zinc coated or duplex powder coated with coat curing according to RAL to prevent corrosion.

The ropes are made using HERKULES material (16 mm thick ropes made from polypropylene with a steel internal core) and are connected with plastic joints. Steps boards are made of high quality HDPE (high-pressure, full-coloured polyethylene, which is characterised by high colour stability, UV resistance and mainly safety because it is rigid and there is no risk of injury caused by sharp broken fragments).All fastening material is galvanized or stainless steel.
